29 March 2019 is the date set for the United Kingdom to leave the European Union. The UK's withdrawal impacts chemical compliance for companies that are reliant on UK registrations and authorisations under existing EU regulations. Upon withdrawal, EU based companies may be subject to new obligations under these aforementioned regulations; and UK based companies may be liable to obligations under UK law.
